China Overseas Fisheries Association (COFA) and SHOU were authorized by the Chinese government to jointly undertake the CJM and GIS fishing activities data collection. The CJM fishing activities data were submitted to the Secretariat in accordance with requirements of CMM02-2017. But it is difficult for Chinese squid jigging vessels to meet the requirements of CMM 02-2017 absolutely in such a short time, because there are hundreds of squid jigging vessels fishing in the South Pacific area, it needs much more time and effort to collect all the data required by the CMM from the vessels. China will continue working on the improvement of the squid data collection so as to meet requirements of CMM 02-2017 completely

COFA and SHOU have a programme for the observers' training, selection, dispatch, etc. Each year 1-2 scientific observers are dispatched to Chinese CJM fishing vessels. The annual observer implementation report will be submitted to the Secretariat before the deadline in CMM02-2017 and also it will be described in national report.

China fisheries Authority has implemented VMS reporting since 2006. It is mandatory that all fishing vessels shall have an operating VMS on board when fishing overseas, and they shall register with details of the vessel information which cannot be altered without Authority permission. Each vessel shall keep their VMS device open 24-hour and reports the position back to the Authority at least once every four hours. Content of the VMS Position Reports includes vessel flag, vessel name, vessel registration number, latitude and longitude, date and time, which conforms to the requirements in CMM 02-2017. The investigation of VMS reports is held regularly, and for those vessels whose VMS device are turned off on purpose and/or tampered, sanctions would be taken against the vessel owner.

SHOU has developed a fishing activities data checking program to verify the data. First, SHOU will check whether the fishing activities are normal and conform to the domestic law. The customs will check the legality of some kinds of fisheries product imported into China territory, and if the product is related to IUU activities the import will be forbidden.2) If a China flagged vessel was engaged in IUU activities, it would be put in the IUU list. All the vessels included in the list will lose the permission to fisheries, and any chartering of these vessels is prohibited. In the same time other companies are prohibited to provide them with any service, such as refuelling, supplying food, water, etc.3) Cooperation with other countries on IUU issues. Once China has the clue of any possible IUU activities, in which Chinese vessels might be engaged, we share the information with other countries and conduct investigations with them to clarify the facts..
