

PERU ANNUAL IMPLEMENTATION REPORT OF THE REVISED INTERIM MEASURES FOR PELAGIC FISHERIES 2011

Peru has implemented the revised interim measures for high seas pelagic adopted in February 2011 through the following actions:

Measures of fishing effort:

For the year 2011 Peru merely authorized, for fishing in the area of the SPRFMO, the gross tonnage (GT) contained in table 1 of the document 'Interim measures of 2011'.

The gross tonnage (GT) of the Peruvian flag vessels in 2011 was limited to 53,560.09 and was not exceeded at any time in 2011. Also, the actual presence of fishing vessels was verified by VMS reports and reports of catches.

Management of capture:

Ministerial Resolution No. 128-2011-PRODUCE establishes mandatory reporting and verification capture by satellite tracking system, allowing control of the Peruvian flag vessels catching level in the SPRFMO area.

In December 2011 Peru recorded a total catch of 674 tons in the area of the SPRFMO, which is consistent with the 40% reduction of the catch recorded in 2010.

Data collection and reporting:

The monthly catch data and VMS records were provided by Peru in established formats. Peru also provided data from the two ships that have been actively fishing in the area of the SPRFMO in 2011.

The Peru provides verified data in accordance with the document 'Standards for the collection, reporting, verification and exchange of data'.

Monitoring and control measures:

All Peruvian flag vessels authorized to conduct mining activities in the area of the SPRFMO have a satellite tracking system in accordance with Peruvian law in force.
