

*PERU ANNUAL IMPLEMENTATION REPORT
OF THE REVISED INTERIM MEASURES FOR
PELAGIC FISHERIES 2010*

**MANAGEMENT OF THE PERUVIAN STATE IN THE FRAMEWORK
OF SOUTH PACIFIC REGIONAL FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ORGANISATION (SPRFMO)**

1. The Convention on the Conservation and Management of High Seas Fishery Resources of the South Pacific Ocean and the Final Act of the International Consultation was adopted on November 14th, 2009.
2. In the 8th meeting performed in Auckland-New Zealand on November 14th, 2009, Revised Interim Measures for the Pelagic Fisheries -the same that will be review at the second session of the Preparatory Conference of SPRFMO- were established on the basis of the *Trachurus species* stock assessment that will be entrusted to the Scientific Working Group of SPRFMO. This group has recently met in Viña del Mar and it has issued a report concluding that the *Trachurus species* state is critical; as a consequence, it requires the adoption of urgent and effective measures.
3. In order to strengthen national high seas fishery and assert our presence in the Southeastern Pacific Ocean, the Peruvian government has issued a series of regulatory measures that are focused on aspects of registration, control and monitoring for those vessels interested in developing extractive activities of *Trachurus species* in the area of the High Seas and in the management of the information about their catches.
4. In the framework of the commitment established in the Revised Interim Measures for the Pelagic Fishery, Peru reached the list of 92 Peruvian vessels with 76,806.09 GT recorded in the Special Register for developing extractive activities of *Trachurus species* with parameters established in the appendix 7 of the document "Standard for the collection, reporting, verification and exchange of data." (October 6th, 2008)
5. The transmission of information about the capacity in GT (Gross tonnage) of the 88 Peruvian vessels that have performed commercial fishing until 2009 in the area of the SPRFMO was fulfilled. This information was verified through VMS records and Catch reports of the Revised Interim Measures-SPRFMO (according with the number 7).
6. Nowadays, remitting to the Interim Secretary of SPRFMO the estimated monthly of the *Trachurus species* catches of vessels registered in the Special Register for developing extraction activities of *Trachurus species* in High Seas is fulfilled according to the number 15 of the Reviewed Interim Measures -SPRFMO.
7. Finally, Peru is in constant coordination with the Interim Secretary of the SPRFMO, in the acquittal of different doubts and information exchange.
