COMM 8 – Doc 06 Regional processes relevant for SPRFMO

Secretariat

1. BACKGROUND

The Secretariat receives numerous requests for inputting in several regional processes on different fisheries management related areas. These inputs not only cover those where the Commission instructed the Secretariat to engage such as the ABNJ¹ or FIRMS² but also many others where SPRFMO is required to provide technical input. A non-exhaustive list of the latest would be: CITES on "Proposals to amend Appendices I and II for marine species" (12/03/2019), OECD on "Closing Gaps in National Regulations Against IUU Fishing" and "Intensifying the Fight Against IUU Fishing at the Regional Level" (06/03/2019), or several FAO requests "Implementation of the Code of Conduct for Responsible Fisheries" (26/02/2019), "Best Practices to Prevent and Reduce ALDFG" (09/05/2019) or the "FAO Study on Transhipment" (23/09/2019).

However, there are other regional processes concerning specific policy areas where the Secretariat has been requested to provide input. Some of these regional processes relevant for SPRFMO would be: BBNJ³, CBD⁴, the SDG 14⁵, etc.

2. OTHER REGIONAL PROCESSES

The Commission has not given a clear line to take or allocated the human and financial resources for the Secretariat to engage or not on these regional processes related with the conservation and management of high seas fisheries resources (from a policy point of view) and therefore the Secretariat is looking for guidance from the Commission on how to approach these regional processes.

The Commission is invited to consider providing guidance to the Secretariat on the level of engagement (if any) and how to make it operational⁶.
