Requirement: Reason for Attaining CNCP Status

Liberia: Our reason for attaining CNPC status with SPRMO is because we have in our Liberian Registry a large number of reefer vessels that can participate in transshipment activities in the SPRFMO Convention Area.

Requirement: Commitment to Cooperate Fully in the Implementation of Conservation and Management Measures Adopted by the Commission

Liberia: We are committed to fully cooperating in the implementation of conservation and management measures adopted by the Commission and will ensure that reefer vessels flying the Liberian flag and engaging in activities in the Convention Area comply with the provisions of the Convention. Some of those conservation and management measures include:

- CMM 1.01 Conservation and Management Measure for Trachurus Murphyi;
- CMM 1.02 Conservation and Management Measure for Gillnets in the SPRFMO Convention Area;
- CMM 1.03 Standards for the Collection, Reporting, Verification and Exchange of Data;
- CMM 1.04 Conservation and Management Measure Establishing a List of Vessels Presumed To Have Carried Out Illegal, Unreported and Unregulated Fishing Activities in the SPRFMO Convention Area.

Full Data on Historical Fisheries, Including:

- Nominal catches;
- Number/type of vessels;
- Name of fishing vessels;
- Fishing effort/fishing areas.

NOTE: This requirement does not apply to Liberia for non-domestic fishing activities. In the event there is consideration for registration of fishing vessels in SPRFMO's Convention Area, Liberia will provide notification of the same, including:

- Nominal catches;
- Number/type of vessels;
- Name of fishing vessels;
- Fishing effort/fishing areas.

However, we may provide a spreadsheet identifying currently registered Liberian-flagged reefer vessels by name, type, and IMO number.

Requirement: Any Further Relevant Information as Determined by the Commission

Liberia: In regards to this requirement, Liberia would be pleased to review any additional relevant information determined by the Commission in order to gather the necessary information for submission to SPRFMO.
