Conservation and Management Measure for Trachurus murphyi

Effort management

Paragraph 5:

Gross tonnage (GT) limits for Korea are stipulated as 15,222GT for the 2013 fishing season. Accordingly, one fishing vessel named *Gwangja* (GT: 3,012) participated in fishing operation in the Convention Area in 2013.

Catch management

Paragraph 8:

Korea's 2013 catch limit for horse mackerel (*Trachurus murphyi*) is set at 3,764 tons. However, Vanuatu made arrangements to transfer its unused entitlements (a total of 2,100 tons) to Korea. Under CMM 1.01 paragraph 10, Korea has submitted an agreement between Korea and Vanuatu on the catch transfer to the Secretariat. Accordingly, it can be interpreted that Korea's 2013 catch limit has increased to a total of 5,864 tons (3,764+1,500+600 tons) and, 5,267 tons of horse mackerel has been caught by Korean-flagged vessels as of 31 Dec. 2013.
