## Chinese Taipei's 2013 Implementation Report

---

### 2013 Chinese Taipei's Annual Report on the Implementation of Conservation and Management Measures adopted at the First Meeting of the South Pacific Regional Fisheries Management Organization

#### **CMM 1.01 Conservation and Management Measure for *Trachurus murphyi***

Chinese Taipei is not currently participating in the *Trachurus murphyi* fishery in the Convention Area, so this CMM is not applicable to Chinese Taipei. However, Chinese Taipei, as it did for the past several years, has submitted its annual national report regarding its 2012 Jumbo flying squid fishery for the First Meeting of the Scientific Committee as other Members who fish for *Trachurus murphyi* and thus are required by para. 19 of this CMM.

#### **CMM 1.02 Conservation and management measure for Gillnets in the SPRFMO Convention Area**

Taking into account the UNGA Resolution 46/215 Large-scale pelagic driftnet fishing and its impact on the living marine resources of the world's oceans and seas, Chinese Taipei has adopted and revised when necessary from 1992 relevant Directions prohibiting its vessels from engaging in fishing activities with drift-nets on the high seas. Vessels flagged to Chinese Taipei operate with neither large-scale pelagic driftnets nor deep-water gillnets on the high seas.

**CMM 1.03 Conservation and Management Measure on Standards for the Collection, Reporting, Verification and Exchange of Data**

1. Data on fishing activities and the impacts of fishing
  - (1) Para. 1(a): Chinese Taipei has provided the data on its 2012 annual catch for Jumbo flying squid.
  - (2) Para. 1(e): Chinese Taipei has provided the information on its 2012 fishing activity with the data grouped to 5x5 degrees, including vessel number and catch for each month, and the data on its 2012 landings and transshipment for Jumbo flying squid. In addition, there was no non-target species information recorded in 2012 due to the nature of its squid jigging fishery.
2. Vessel data  
Chinese Taipei has provided a list of its vessels authorized to fish in the Convention Area for 2014.
3. Vessel Monitoring System – frequency of reporting  
Chinese Taipei has revised its domestic regulations and ordered its vessels operating in the Convention Area to report their VMS positions in accordance with para. 4(b)(i) of this CMM.

**CMM 1.04 Conservation and Management Measure Establishing a List of Vessels Presumed to Have Carried Out Illegal, Unreported and Unregulated Fishing Activities in the SPRFMO Convention Area**

Chinese Taipei did not detect in 2013 any vessel presumed to have carried out IUU activities in the Convention Area and thus has not transmitted any list of such vessels to the Executive Secretary as required by para. 2 of this CMM.
