CTC-03-10

Technical Editing of the SPRFMO CMMs Secretariat

At the 2015 Commission Meeting, some Members requested that the Secretariat produce a compilation of effective SPRFMO Conservation and Management Measures so that they could be downloaded as one document.

In response to this request, the Secretariat harmonised the formats and initiated a proofing of the CMMs with the intent to obtain a clean version which would include corrections of a non-substantive, purely technical nature. Australia, Chile, the European Union, New Zealand and Chinese Taipei participated in this endeavour and a table containing all the corrections agreed upon by this group (with exception of very insignificant edits e.g. spelling) was circulated to all Members on 20 May 2015 (see attached).

It was then decided to propose these corrections to the Commission for discussion at its 2016 meeting.

This paper is being provided to assist the CTC in its consideration of developing a procedure for the continuous technical editing (proofing) of the SPRFMO CMMs.
