1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

2. ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

a. Adoption of the Agenda

The adoption of the agenda will follow Rule of Procedure 4.3

b. Meeting Documents

Meeting documentation, location and access will be presented. A list of meeting documents (CTC5-Doco2) will be made available.

3. VESSEL MONITORING SYSTEM (VMS)

a. Secretariat's report on implementation and operation of the Commission VMS

The Secretariat will present a report of the work carried out during 2017 in terms of the implementation of the Commission VMS and the work with CLS (CTC5-Doco3).

b. Report of the VMS Working Group and review of CMM 06-2017 (VMS)

The Chairperson of the VMS Working Group, Mr Luis Molledo (European Union), will present the inter-sessional work of the WG which has produced documents relating to COMM6-Propo1. Note: last year the VMS working group recommended that a review be undertaken at the 2018 annual meeting to consider any further resourcing implications on the Secretariat at that time.

c. Review of requirements for accessing VMS data

The proposed administrative process for accessing VMS data (CTC5-Doc13) will be presented by the Secretariat. The CTC will also review the requirements for use and release of VMS data.

d. Payment of Satellite Airtime costs

Section 7 of last year's Commission confirmed that all satellite airtime costs in 2017 will be responsibility of the flag State (or flagged vessels) for their flagged vessels. The Commission has asked the VMS WG to address the matter of who bears the cost for satellite airtime as matter of priority.

e. Final Acceptance of the SPRFMO VMS solution hosted by CLS

As per Appendix 4, milestone 11 of the SPRFMO-CLS contract, the Commission will be asked to decide whether to accept the system for an initial 24-month period. Based upon previous discussions the CTC is invited to make a recommendation for the Commission.

4. SPRFMO OBSERVER PROGRAMME

a. Report of the Observer Programme Working Group

The Chairperson of the OPWG, Mr Michael Tosatto (USA), will present a summary of the work conducted inter-sessionally.

b. Consideration of a proposal for the SPRFMO Observer Programme

COMM6-Propo2 regarding a new CMM for the SPRFMO Observer programme will be considered.

5. ASSESSMENT OF COMPLIANCE OF MEMBERS AND CNCPs

a. Presentation of the Draft Compliance Report

After receiving the Members' and CNCPs' Implementation Reports 90 days before the meeting, the SPRFMO Secretariat has compiled the pertinent information and prepared the Draft Compliance Report (CTC5-Doco4) which will be made available to Members and CNCPs 14 days before the meeting.

b. Follow-up actions taken since the last meeting

Document CTC5-Doco5 will be presented by the Secretariat. This paper summarises actions taken by Members and CNCPs in response to compliance issues identified at the previous meeting or to recommendations made by the Commission in this regard.

c. Development of a Provisional Compliance Report

At its annual meeting, the CTC is requested to develop a Provisional Compliance Report (CTC5-Doc11) to forward to the Commission for its consideration.

6. MATTERS CONCERNING IMPLIMENTATION OF CURRENT CMMs

a. Transhipment outside the SPRFMO Area

Explanatory note CTC5-Doco7 will be presented, and the CTC is invited to consider this note when formulating its recommendations in relation to COMM6-Propo8

b. Pair Trawling within the SPRFMO Area

Paper CTC5-Doco8 will be presented and the CTC is invited to make suitable recommendations.

c. Implementation of CMM 07-2017 (Port Inspection)

Paper CTC5-Doco9 will be presented and the CTC is invited to make suitable recommendations

7. EXAMINATION OF CURRENT AND DRAFT IUU LISTS

a. Examination of the 2018 Draft IUU List

The CTC will examine the Draft IUU List (CTC5-10) and shall remove vessels as per paragraph 10 of CMM 04-2017.

b. Examination of the Current (2017) IUU List

The CTC will examine the Current IUU List including any available updates.

c. Development of a 2018 Provisional IUU List

Following the examination of the Draft and current IUU List, the CTC shall adopt a 2018 Provisional IUU List and recommend to the Commission which, if any, vessels shall be removed from the Current IUU List.

8. ASSESSMENT OF COOPERATING NON-CONTRACTING PARTIES' APPLICATIONS

a. Curacao

The CTC shall assess Curaçao's application for CNCP status (CTC4-Doc1, Annex 1) and provide recommendations and technical advice to the Commission

b. Liberia

The CTC shall assess Liberia's application for CNCP status (CTC4-Doc12, Annex 2) and provide recommendations and technical advice to the Commission

c. Other applications

The CTC shall consider other CNCP applications and provide recommendations to the Commission

9. OTHER CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES

a. New CMM Proposal - Exploratory Pot Fishing (Cook Islands)

The Cook Islands will be invited to present COMM6-Propo3 and after discussion the CTC shall develop its recommendations and technical advice for the Commission. The SPRFMO Scientific Committee's proposed advice in relation to this proposal has been made available (COMM6-Doco7) and is expected to be finalised prior to the meeting.

b. CMM 01-2017 Trachurus murphyi (paragraph 25)

Vanuatu will be invited to present COMM6-Propo4 after which the CTC shall review the measure and develop its recommendations and technical advice for the Commission (refer to the CTC list of documents for additional related papers).

c. CMM 03-2017 Management of Bottom Fishing (paragraph 27)

New Zealand and Australia will be invited to present COMM6-Propo5 (refer to the CTC list of documents for additional related papers). The CTC shall review the proposal and develop its recommendations and technical advice for the Commission.

d. CMM 10-2017 Establishment of a Compliance and Monitoring Scheme (paragraph 19) The European Union will be invited to present COMM6-Propo6 after which the CTC shall review the measure and develop its recommendations and technical advice for the Commission.

e. CMM 11-2015 Boarding and Inspection

The United States of America will be invited to present COMM6-Propo7 after which the CTC shall review the proposal and develop its recommendations and technical advice for the Commission.

f. CMM 12-2017 Regulation of Transhipment & other Transfer activities (paragraph 10) Korea will be invited to present COMM6-Propo8 after which the CTC shall review the measure and develop its recommendations and technical advice for the Commission.

g. CMM 13-2017 Exploratory Fisheries (consequential amendments)

New Zealand will be invited to present COMM6-Propog after which the CTC shall review the measure and develop its recommendations and technical advice for the Commission.
