

7TH MEETING OF THE COMPLIANCE AND TECHNICAL COMMITTEE (CTC)

Port Vila, Vanuatu, 10 to 12 February 2020

CTC 7 – Doc 06 Follow-up actions taken in relation to the 2019 Final Compliance report Secretariat

1. Background

This paper reports on follow-up actions taken by Members and CNCPs in relation to their need for either a Compliance review or a Compliance Action plan as identified in the 2019 Final Compliance Report (Annex 4 of the COMM7-Report).

In that document, the Commission agreed that, consistent with the CTC recommendations, the following should apply:

- a. Members and CNCPs that were asked by the CTC to prepare a Compliance Review, shall transmit to the Secretariat any missing information, if the relevant information has not yet been provided, within 90 days after the end of the Commission Meeting¹ (being 27 April 2019).
- b. Members and CNCPs that were asked by the CTC to prepare a Compliance Action Plan shall provide the Secretariat with detailed information on the steps taken to respond to and rectify the non-compliance and/or improve the implementation of the relevant obligations, within six months after the end of the Commission Meeting (being 27 July 2019).

The other notable CMMs which may require Member investigations and/or follow-up reporting to the Commission are CMM 04-2019 (IUU Vessel List), CMM 07-2019 (Port Inspection) and CMM 11-2015 (Boarding and Inspection). Investigations/actions which have been requested or required under CMM 04-2019 are reported within paper CTC7-Doc12 (Revised Draft IUU Vessel List). Investigations/actions which have been requested or required under CMM 07-2019 are reported within paper CTC7-Doc10 (Port Inspections Implementation report). To date there have been no Boarding and Inspection activities carried out in the SPRFMO Area.

2. Follow-up Actions

2.1. Compliance Action Plans

The 2019 Final Compliance report asked 2 Members and 1 CNCP to develop a Compliance action plan to rectify non-compliance and/or improve implementation of obligations. Table 1 shows the current status of those obligations.

2.2. Compliance Review

As part of their Compliance Review, 1 CNCP committed to improving their data for 2019. However, there were no comparable activities identified during the 2018/19 assessment period.
