<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Note that the Secretariat has improved its reporting on the Scientific Support Fund to enhance transparency and usability for Members and the Secretariat.• Note that the SSF has been well resourced and utilised by Members throughout the year, and a combination of voluntary contributions and rescheduling of planned activities has created healthy end of year balances last year and this year.• Recommend that the Commission approve the accrual to the 2026-27 financial year of unspent 2025-26 appropriations (forecast to be \$157 505) for the continuation of planned activities.• Note that this accrual would be sufficient to fund planned activities for 2026-27 therefore the Scientific Support Fund Budget Category 10 is zero in the draft budget for the Financial Year 2026-27 (FAC13-Doc13).• Consider whether the current annual planning and budgeting cycle fulfils the requirement for a review of the budget category at least every four years, or whether a fuller review of the category and Fund is warranted.
