Faroe Islands 2013 Implementation Report

Faroe Islands Report on the implementation in 2013 of SPRFMO management measures and compliance and enforcement procedures

The Kingdom of Denmark in respect of the Faroe Islands is a Member of the Convention on the Conservation and Management of High Seas Fishery Resources in the South Pacific Ocean (SPRFMO).

Faroe Islands is entitled in 2013 to fish for *Trachurus murphyi* as provided for in CMM 1.01.

The competent authority of the Faroe Islands has authorised one Faroese vessel to fish for ***Trachurus murphyi*** in 2013. However, the vessel did not enter the fishery. Therefore the Faroe Islands have no data to report according to Article 12, 14, 16 and 19 of CMM 1.01 and the reporting requirements as set out in CMM 1.03, except the requirements in Article 2(c).

The obligations for Members and CNCPs according to CMM 1.03 regarding data on fishing activities and the impact of fishing, vessel data, observer data and vessel monitoring system data are covered by the national Faroese legislation as general requirements for the fishing fleet and the appropriate national authorities in the Faroe Islands.
