**VMS Tenderer Evaluation Criteria (EU)**

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**Evaluation Criteria**
**Technical quality**

Tenderers must submit evidence of their legal, economic, financial, technical and professional capacity to perform the contract. The information in the technical proposal must be consistent with the terms of reference and must be signed by the tenderer.

The assessment of technical quality of the proposal will be based on the ability of the tenderer to meet the purpose of the contract as described in the terms of reference.

The quality of technical offers will be evaluated in accordance with the award criteria and the associated weighting as detailed in the evaluation grid below

Each Commission Member will communicate to the Secretariat the list of tenders with their respective scores.

The Secretariat will draw a shortlist of the [3] highest ranking tenderers based on the aggregated scores received and will inform Members and the shortlisted tenderers.

The shortlisted tenderers will be invited to interview (either in person or via the web) during the meeting of the Technical and Compliance Committee.

In the time between being informed and the interview, tenderers may be given the opportunity to present their product via Webinar if possible.
