## SC8-Doc10 Call for Interest to Organise forthcoming Scientific Committee Meetings Secretariat

## **Background**

According to Rule of Procedure 3 "Before the end of each annual meeting, the Commission<sup>1</sup> shall, if possible, decide on the date and location of the next annual meeting".

To facilitate medium term planning both for SPRFMO Members' national scientific and research administrations and for the Secretariat, the Scientific Committee (SC) members are requested to consider how feasible it would be for them to organise forthcoming SC meetings<sup>2</sup>.

This exercise is not a formal commitment (unless confirmation is given by the SC member), but a finding exercise to check where potentially SC meetings could be organised in the next three years. Therefore, each year column is open to more than one Member.
